Within a relatively short period of time, the EK corneal graft procedure has become the preferred technique for patients with Fuchs' dystrophy and other endothelial disorders of the cornea. However, traditional full-thickness PK is still the most appropriate option when the majority of your cornea is diseased or scarred.

### Cornea Transplant Surgery: Procedure, Recovery, Rejection

If the cornea has progressed to diffuse edema with bullae formation, a combination procedure of cataract surgery with endothelial transplantation may be more appropriate. The corneal endothelial cells can be directly visualized and assessed using specular microscopy, and a central endothelial cell density can be determined.

The Penetrating Keratoplasty (PK) technique largely overshadowed Lamellar Keratoplasty (LK) because LK had poor visual outcomes related to irregularity of the dissected surfaces and scarring in the tissue interfaces.[1]
